Teaching experiences

2004-2009 : Professor at Institut de Musique Sacrée de Lyon. Subjects taught : vocal technique, music theory, sight-reading, movement training for singers

2005-2011 : Guest professor at Conservatorio Superior de Música de Buenos Aires « Manuel de Falla » for five master-classes on Baroque singing and gesture. Music direction and stylistic preparation of the soloists for the Early Music Department's project « Lecciones de Tinieblas » in 2011.

2006 : French Baroque music interpretation workshop with the « Chœur à la française » ensemble at Université Catholique de Lyon.

2007 : Guest professor at Conservatoire à Rayonnement Régional d'Annecy for a master-class on M. A. Charpentier's *Messe de Minuit* (stylistic preparation of the soloists, vocal ensemble and orchestra).

In 2010-2011, two sessions on historically informed staging with Baroque gesture, resulting in final performances at Cité des Arts de Chambéry and l'Auditorium Seynod d'Annecy (guest director).

2012 : Assistant conductor to Gabriel Garrido during a Baroque training course at Rencontres Baroques de Montfrin. Stylistic preparation of the soloists and director of a staged performance of A. Banchieri's *Il Festino*.

2012 : Guest professor at the drama school Théâtre des Lumières de Mont de Marsan (Landes) for a masterclass on Baroque theatre, gesture and historical French pronunciation and declamation. Work on La Fontaine's fables and Lully's tragédies lyriques.
